



GUINEA PIG POOP CHART

Knowing the difference between normal guinea pig poo and abnormal poo can give you clues on your furry friend's state of health.




HEALTHY POO

Oval shaped with a uniform consistency. Colour should be medium to dark brown.




CLUMPY POO

Possibly a sign of a gut issue or your guinea pig's rectal muscles may be aging.




GREENISH POO

This can be cecal pellets which your guinea pig will re-ingest. Perfectly normal for him to gobble this up.




SOFT, SMELLY POO

This is considered diarrhoea. Your guinea pig's diet may be causing some issues. See a vet Immediately!!



TEAR-SHAPED POO

Small and dry poo can be a sign of dehydration.



BLOODY POO

There could be an obstruction, inflammation or tear in the anus or GI tract. See a vet immediately!!!
